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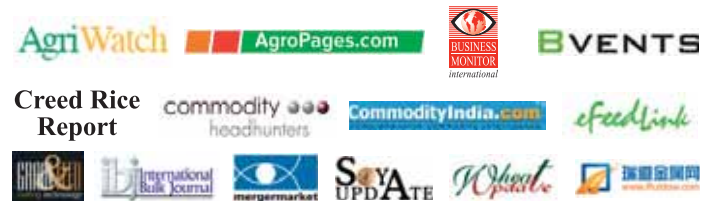

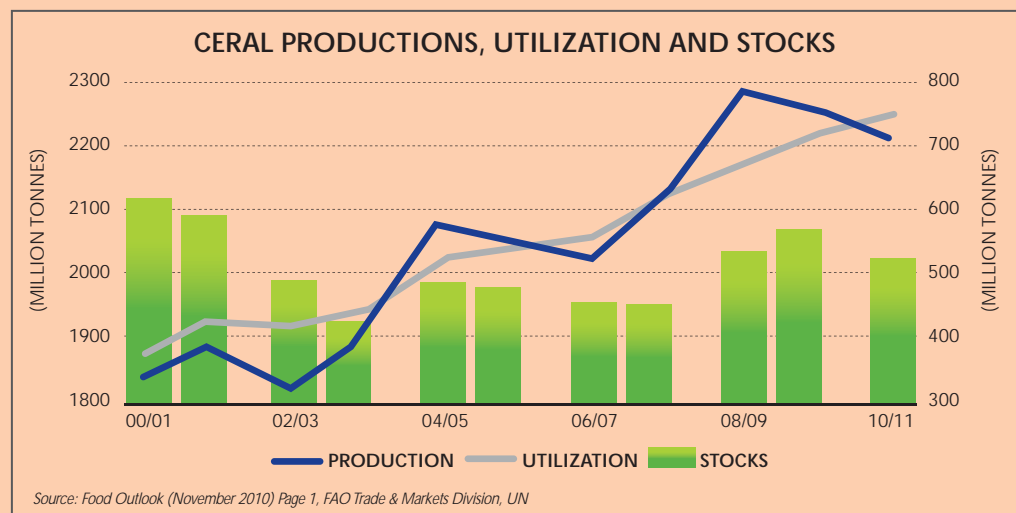

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN GLOBAL GRAINS MARKETS?

Agriculture commodity markets continue to get the attention of funds for investment and speculation, and prices remain volatile due to government intervention, changing weather patterns, currency fluctuations and freight rates. More importantly, with utilization expected to outstrip production for 2011, the pressure of buffer stocks could further impact trade policy.



The upward movements of prices were connected with several factors, the most important of which were a worsening of the outlook for crops in key producing countries, which is likely to require large draw downs of stocks and result in tighter global supply and demand balances in 2010/11 (FAO, UN)

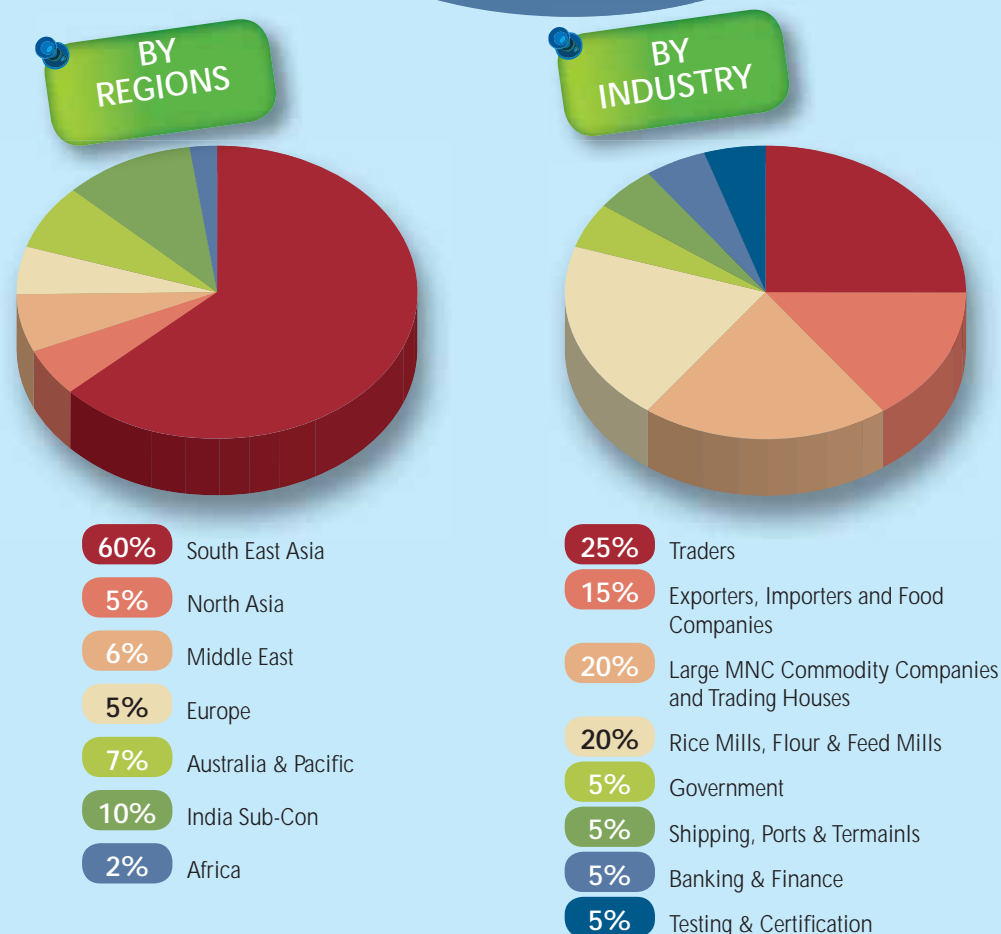
